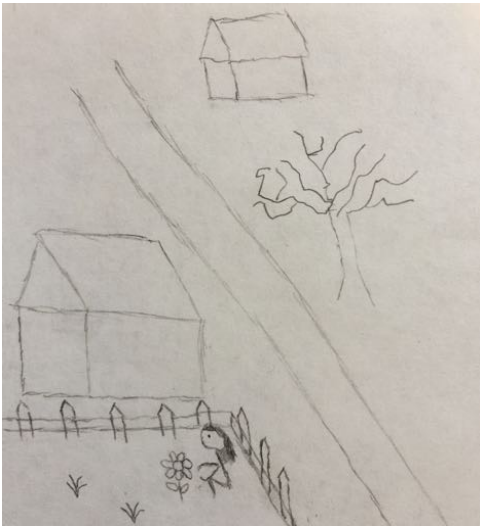
Employees from the gardening delivery service visit Molbak's to buy Steven's plants and bags of bark.



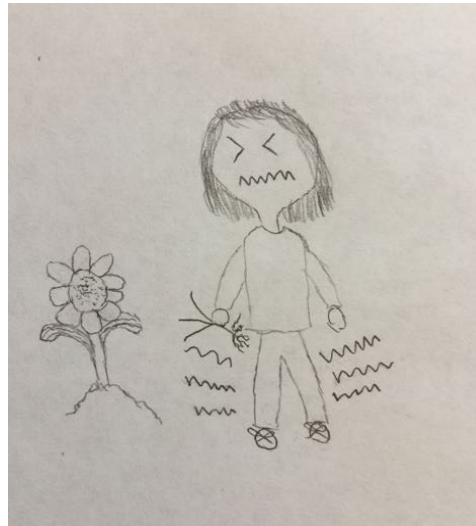
The truck arrives at Steven's house. With the help from the driver, Steven is able to retrieve his plants and bark from the back and get it to his garden.



Steven plants the lavandin and beautifies his yard with the cedar bark. He is happy with the service because he received help and did not have to make multiple trips to the nursery with his small car.



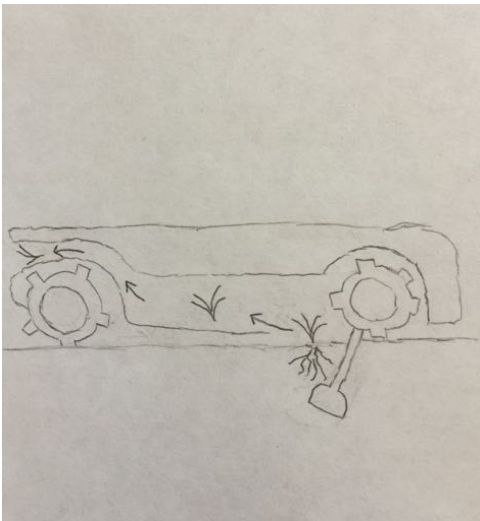

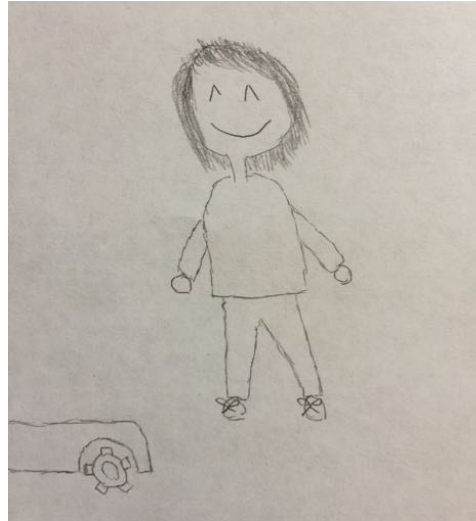
After few hours of pulling weeds, Alexa's thighs are sore from crouching and her knees hurt from kneeling.
